TEXT TRANSCRIBED

Sir

I have your letter with regard to Doccombe Manor and think it will be very desirable to have an opportunity of explaining to you personally all the Information I can afford with respect to that Property.

I shall be in Exeter the whole of this Week, but I shall be entirely engaged at our Chapter Audit on Thursday and a good deal on Friday – I could however see you on the subject on Wednesday Friday or Saturday and Mr Coldridge will also be here to whom we can refer if desirable.
