**SUMMARY:**

Letter, 30<sup>th</sup> Nov 1765, from Nathaniel Paice to Richard Halford for the D & C at Canterbury about the money is sending up to Canterbury for the renewal of the lease for Herman Katenkamp for Doccombe Manor of £438 13s, via Hoares bank.

Sir

Your letter dated yesterday was received too late for me to pay unto the hands of Mes[ser]s Hoares & Comp[an]y Bankers, the sum of £438 13/- for Mr Herman Katenkamp of Exeter's Renewal, with the Dean & Chapter of Canterbury, for the Manor of Doccombe & Woods. But I shall not fail to make the Payment accordingly, & transmit you Mes[se]rs Hoares receipt for the Money by next Mondays Post. I shall enquire of Mr Bargrave, your receiver, whether the Present subsisting Lease is to be Delivered up to him or Transmitted to you; and do by it as he may inform me is most proper; Mr Katenkamp sent it up to me, to be in readiness to Answer any purpose required.
