SUMMARY:

5.12.1765 Letter from Nathaniel Paice to D & C about the fine for £438 13s for Herman Katenkamp to renew his lease for Doccombe manor & woods. The old leases were taken to Mr Bargrave plus £8 15s 8d.

Sir

By the receipt yesterday of your Favor Dated the 3rd Inst and this day by that of the 4th. I have instructions how to procede with the old Leases of Doccombe manor and Woodes, which were accordingly delivered to Mr Bargrave, and the sum paid to him of £8.15.8 on your account, The receipt you have Transmitted to me, of the Rev[eren]d Dr Walwyn, Treasurer of the Chapter of Canterbury, for £438.13s, being the Fine of Mr. Katenkamps renewal. I shall forward to that Gentleman. I am sorry to find the Notes sent you were inconvenient, but that is easily Remediable, by your Remitting them up to Mess[er]s Hoares; which in Their hands will serve to answer your separate Draughts to the Several Members.
