SUMMARY

7th December 1751 Certificate of health for John Babbacombe, tanner of Moretonhampstead & Elias Babbacombe, son of Gilbert Babbacombe of Moretonhampstead lessees of a lease for Myland & Le Laugh alias Leen. Elizabeth, John's wife Elizabeth, having recently died.

We the Rector, and, One of the Church Wardens, (John Babbacombe under named, being the other) of the Parish, and parish Church, of - Moretonhampstead, in the County of Devon, and, others, Parishioners' and Inhabitants there, whose names are hereunto Subscribed, Do hereby certify, that the said John Babbacombe of Moretonhampstead afores[ai]d Tanner, and Elias Babbacombe (Son of Gilbert Babbacombe,) of Moretonhampstead afores[ai]d Brother, of the said John Babbacombe,) who are Lives, nominated in a Lease, (with Elizabeth, the Wife of the s[ai]d John Babbacombe, lately deceased) granted by the Dean and Chapt[e]r of Christ Church Canterbury, to the s[ai]d John Babbacombe of certain Estates **known, by the name or Names of Myland, and Le Laugh al[ia]s Leen**, parcell of the Manour of Docombe in Moretonhampstead afores[ai]d; and both now Living, and in good and perfect Health, In Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our Hands this Seventh Day of December in the year of our Lord 1751.
