SUMMARY:

Letter, July 1828 from Mr Barnes to Dean & Chapter about Rev. George Gregory renewing the lease very soon for the manor but he had not told him about the exclusion of the woods as he thought it as best coming from the D &C.

Outside:

Mr Barnes respecting our letting { ? } Woods at Doccombe

Inside:

Since I wrote this Mr Gregory called & said he had the offer. I did not mention the Woods thinking I had no authority, and if it be proposed it should come from the Chapter.

D[ear] Sir

I hope the Chapter will in their offer of Renewal of the Doccombe Manor renew the Wood which Mr Gregory will I am confident make no objection to and eager to get a surrender of all the remaining rights as he may well. I think this may be close & that there can be no objections to it. I am d[ea]r Sir
